



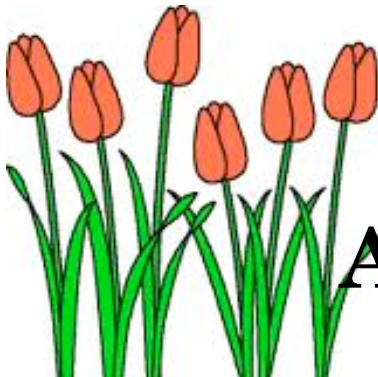

Education Building New Siding Project

Starting Next Tuesday, April 2, our contractor will begin work on replacing the old siding on the Education Building with steel siding. The design will exactly match the wood siding on the sanctuary. The job should take about three weeks to complete. In addition to the siding, the two doors, on the east and north sides, will be replaced with steel clad doors; and we will replace the old swamp cooler on the west side of the building.
