
OUR MISSION: To honor God by leading people to become devoted followers and ministers of Jesus Christ.

OUR GROWING CHURCH

If you've been wondering about the growth of the church in 1999... Membership increased from 121 to 162, a 34% increase.



There are 40 preparatory members, baptized children who have not yet professed publicly their belief in Jesus Christ.

Average attendance has risen from 67 to 83, a 24% increase.

Average attendance for Adult Sunday School/ Children & Youth Bible Study on Sundays has risen from 15 to 27, an 80% increase!


